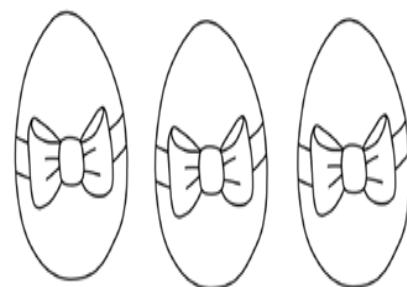
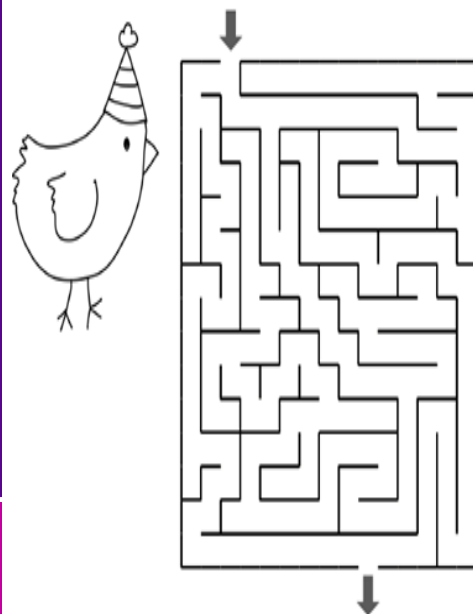
Did you know that the word 'Easter' gets its name from Eastre the Anglo-Saxon goddess who symbolizes the hare and the egg?

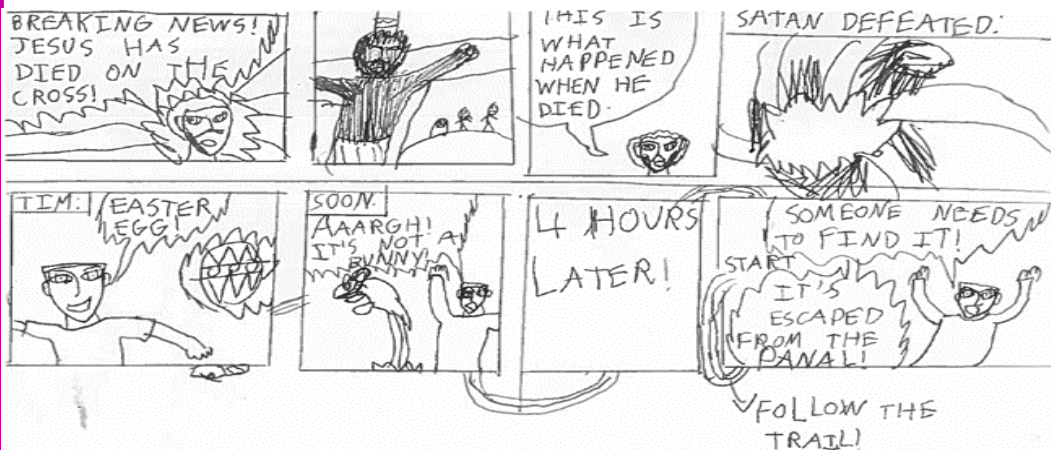
The main purpose of this exercise is to make a joyful noise together and to lift our hearts and spirits.
