Similarly, we put ourselves into the shoes of one couple by looking at artefacts (letters, passports and clothing) that belonged to them.

FUN FACTS

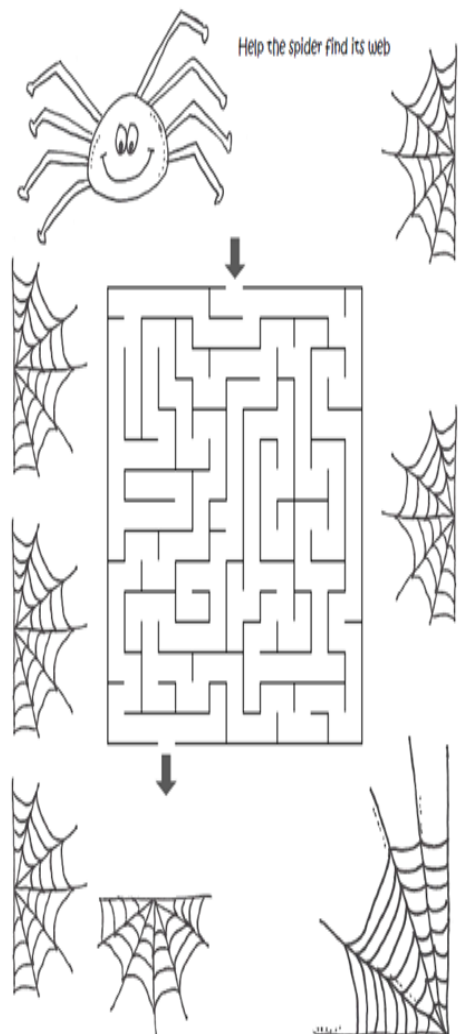
Did you know that when a cat licks its fur it leaves a chemical on it?
