In Science, Year 4 have been exploring sound. Over the last few weeks and continuing until half term, the children are learning about how vibrations cause sounds and how sounds travel.



This week, the children carried out demonstrations of vibrations using different sized tuning forks and water.



In their investigation, they predicted what sounds different sized tuning forks would make and the effect of their vibrations in a beaker of water.

All the children demonstrated a superb ability at working scientifically and collaboratively and with many more experiments to come, they are vibrating with excitement!

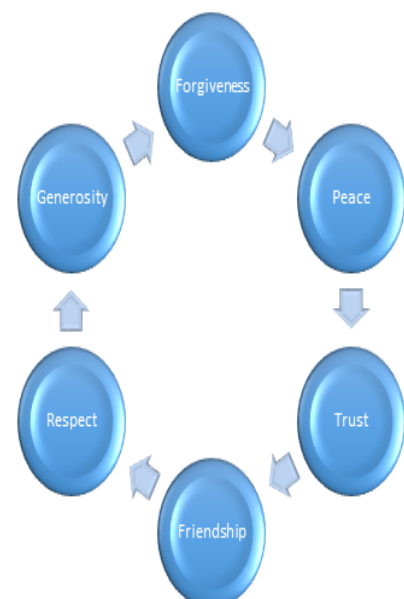
