Unfortunately we did not get to see Boris Johnson visiting as he was in Japan.

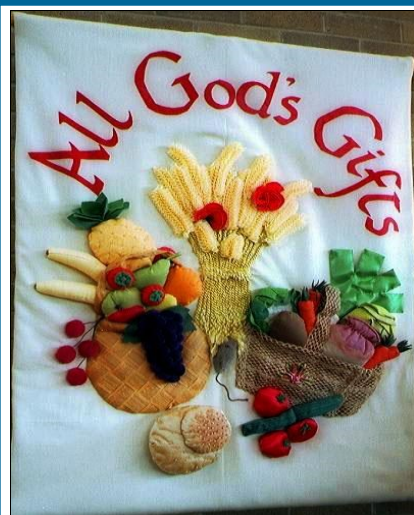
However the children had a very fun and interactive tour around City Hall.
