


Y3 Autumn Term 1 Curriculum Map



Our focus book this term is:

Zoo – by Anthony Browne

Two brothers and their parents spend a day at the zoo, looking at the animals in the cages - or is it that the animals are watching the visitors? This winner of the 1993 Kate Greenaway Medal is a teasing examination of the relationship between man and animals, and the role of zoos.

Write a fact file based on one of the animals in the zoo.

Write and extended narrative based on the orang-utan's dreams.

Create a piece of writing based on the text *My Dad*.

Science – Animals Including Humans; diet and effects
