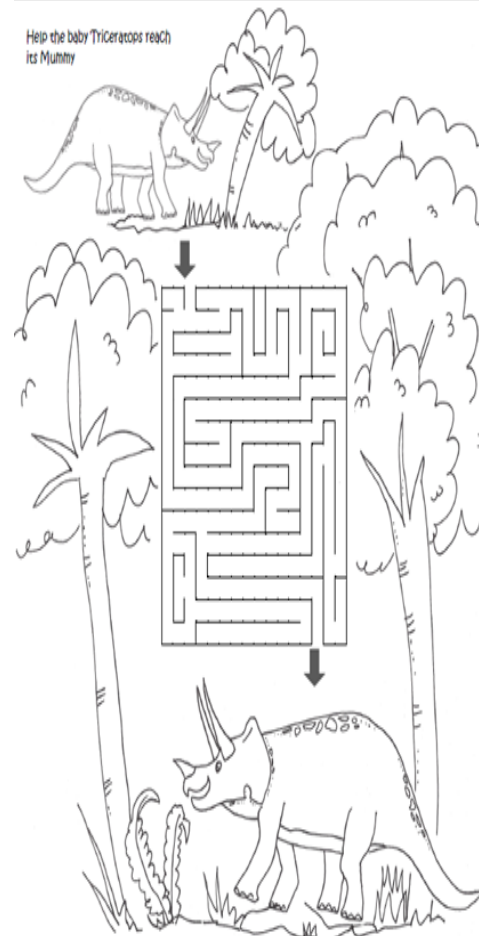


Did you know that there are around 10,000 species of birds around the world?
