Calling all milk bottles!

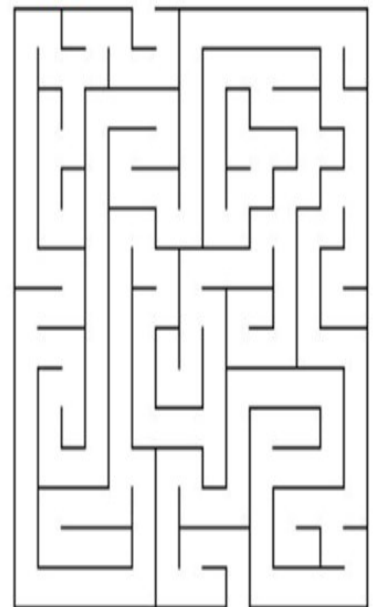
