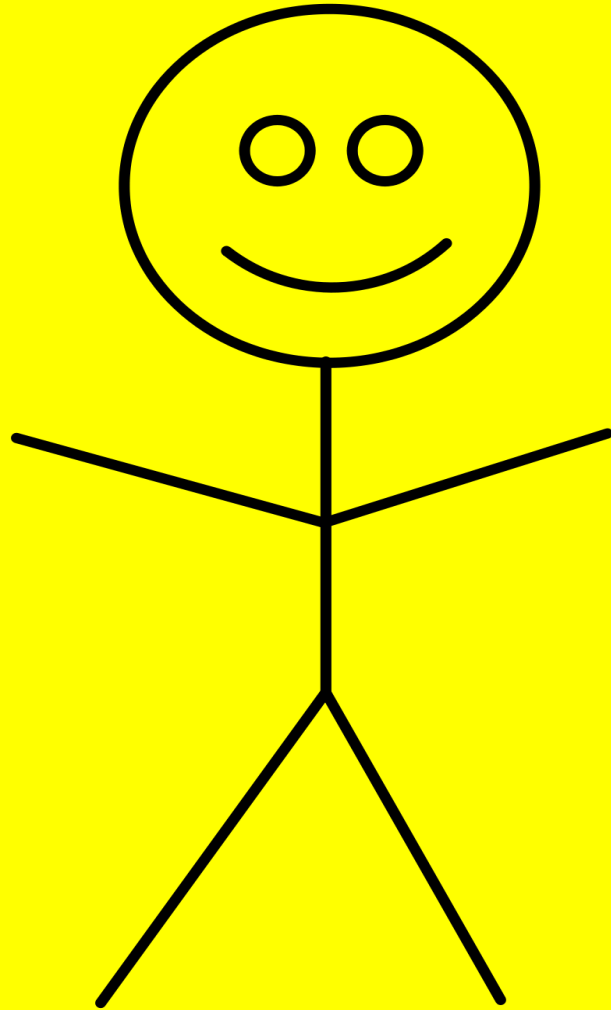
Let's look at our 10 commandments on the display wall.

MAN

- 6: Do not murder
- 7: Do not commit adultery
- 8: Do not steal
- 9: Do not lie
- 10: Do not covet
