There are over 200 breeds of ponies with the Shetland pony being the most popular!

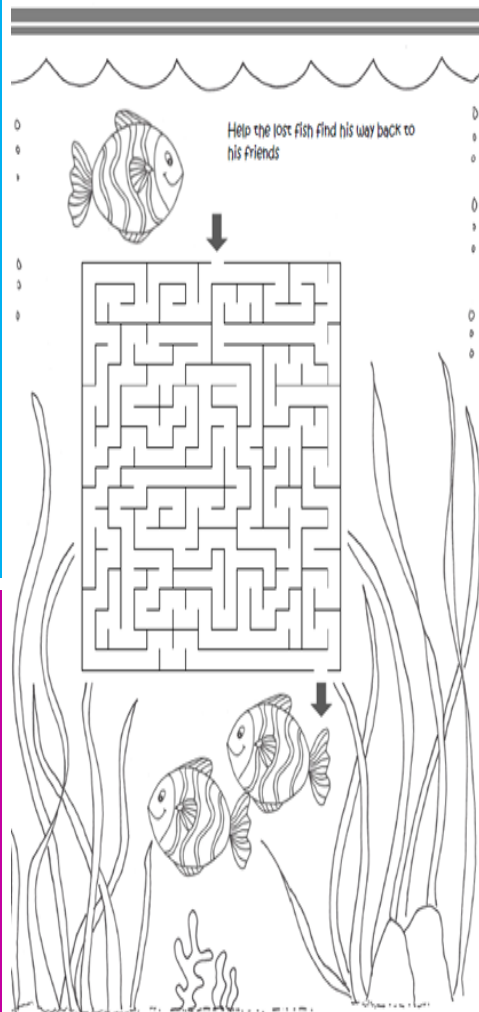

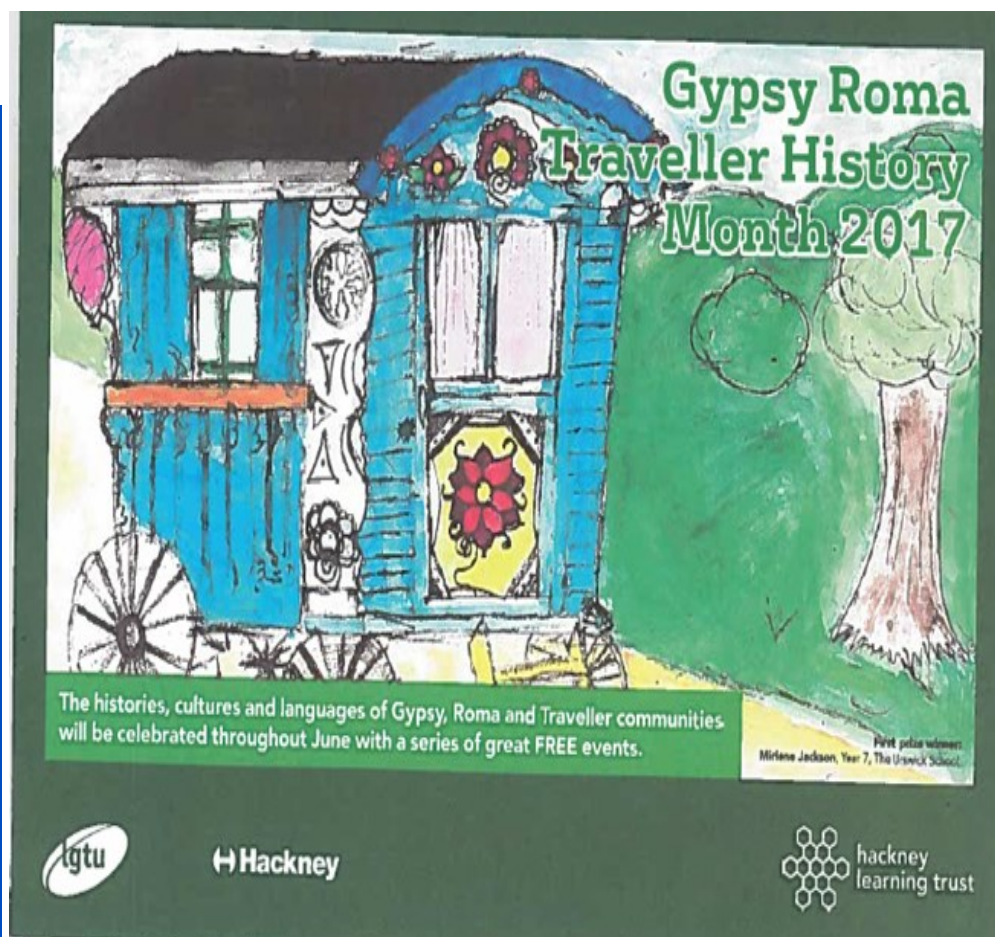
