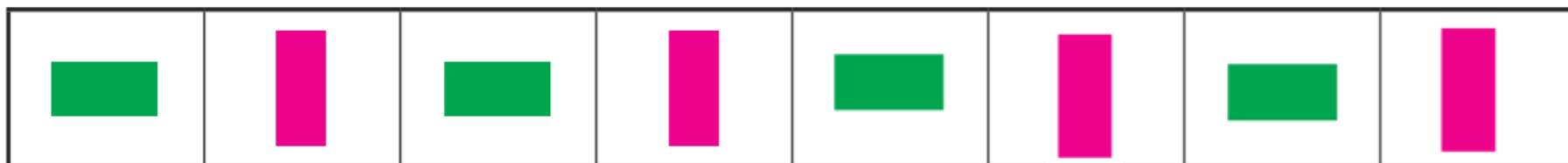
Now it's time to do some Maths.

Please encourage your child to say the chant while you point at the letters below. They will need to say the letter sounds, not the letter names.




**a** is for apple,

**f** is for flower, what  
 a pretty scent.

**g** is for girl,  
**h** is for horse,  
**i** is for insect, climbing  
 up my shorts.  
**j** is for jumping,  
**k** for kangaroo,  
**l** is for legs, marching  
 to the zoo.

**m** is for mountains,  
**n** is for net,  
**o** is for octopus,  
 wiggly and wet.  
**p** is for parrot,  
**q** is for queen,  
**r** is for rabbit, hopping  
 on the green.

**s** is for snake,  
**t** is for tower,  
**u** for umbrella, keeps  
 you dry in a shower.  
**v** is for vulture,  
**w** for wiggly worm,

**x** is for exercising fox,  
 now you take a turn.  
**y** is for yoyo,  
 zip starts with **z**.  
 Now I know my alpha-  
 bet, it's all in my head.

A large, bold, black lowercase letter 'g' is positioned on the left side of the slide.
