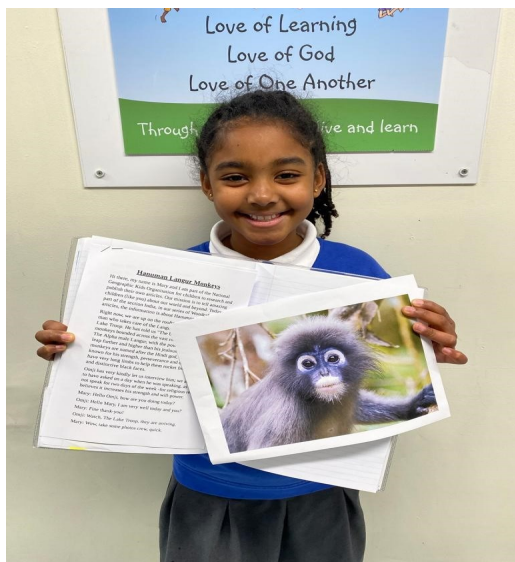

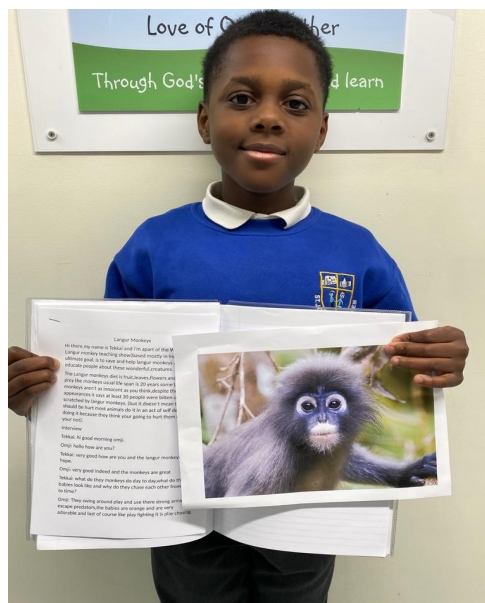
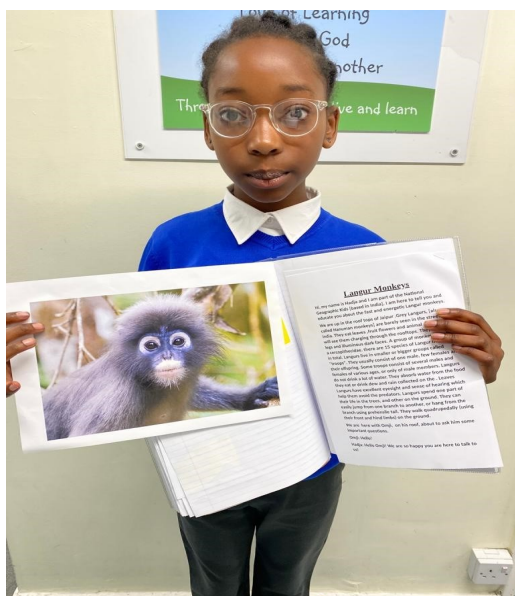
We became reporters for The National Geographic Kids magazine.

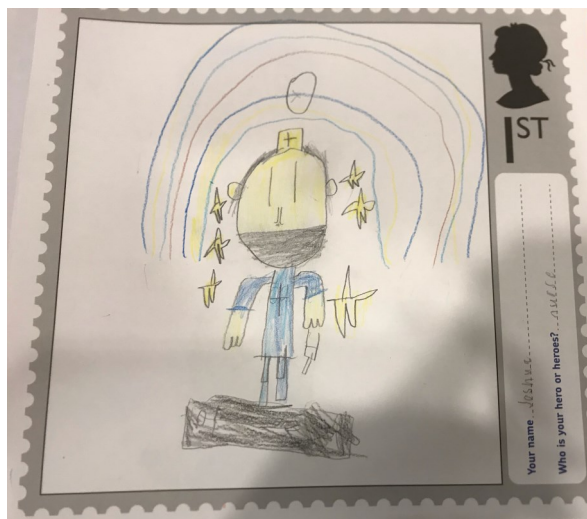

Sienna's amazing drawing for the stamp design competition! (Year 1)



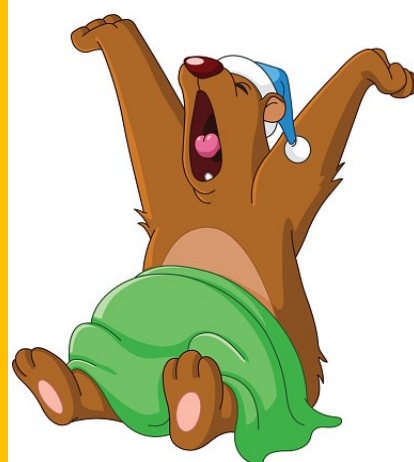

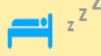

Local GPs will be vaccinating eligible residents at this walk in clinic on a first come first serve basis. Please note this event is for the first dose of the vaccine only.

To be eligible to attend you must be:

- a resident of Hackney or the City of London
- aged over 40+
- a main carer of someone who is clinically extremely vulnerable, elderly or disabled who is at high risk from COVID-19

To help with the sign in process for this event please have your NHS number with you. If you do not have this number, you can still attend, a staff member will be there to help you.

If you are eligible for a vaccination and cannot make this date you can also book an appointment at one of the mass vaccination sites by calling 119 or going online to nhs.uk/coronavirus
